
Malpasset Top-down sweater (pattern by Séverine L.)



Size : S (36/38)

Yarn :

Main Color (03 beige clair) - 6 skeins Belle by Drops (~700 m / 770 yards) Contrast Color (10 vert mousse) -2/3 skein Belle by Drops (~90 m / 100 yards)

Needles/notions :

3.5 mm circular needles3 mm circular needlesStitch markers

Gauge :

20 sts x 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4x4 in) in stockinette sts

Stitches :

Broken Rib (in round) : Round1 : *k1,p1 ; repeat from * to end Round2 : k all sts

Pattern :

Top-down sweater in one piece

Instructions :

Using 3.5mm circular needles CO 58 sts (do not joint)

Row1 (place marker stitches) : p2, pm, p1, pm, p10, pm, p1, pm, p30, pm, p1, pm, p10, pm, p1, pm, p2

Row2 (RS): k2, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k10, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k30, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k10, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k1, slp1 (66 sts)

Row3 (WS): k1, p to 1 sts before end of row, slp1

Row4 (RS) : k to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to 1 st before end of row, slp1 (74 sts)

Row5 : repete row3

Row6 : increase back only

K to m, sm, k1, sm, k to m, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to sm, m1R, sm, k1, sm, k to m, sm, k1, sm, k to 1 st before end of row, slp1 (76 st)

Row7 : repete row3

Row8 : increase body

K to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, k to m, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to sm, m1R, sm, k1, sm, k to m, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to 1 st before end of row, slp1 (76 + 4 sts)

Row9: repete row3

Row10 : increase body + sleeves

k to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to 1 st before end of row, slp1 (80 + 8 = 88 sts)

Row11 : repete row3

Row12 : increase body

K to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, k to m, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to sm, m1R, sm, k1, sm, k to m, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to 1 st before end of row, slp1 (88 + 4 = 92 sts)

Row13 : repete row3

Row14 : increase body + sleeves

k to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to 1 st before end of row, slp1 (92 + 8 = 100 sts)

Row15 : repete row3

Row16 : increase body

K to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, k to m, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to sm, m1R, sm, k1, sm, k to m, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to 1 st before end of row, slp1 (100 + 4 = 104 sts)

Row17 : repete row3

Row18 : increase body + sleeves

k to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to 1 st before end of row, slp1 (104 + 8 = 112 sts)

Row19: repete row3

Row20 : increase body + sleeves

k to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to end of row and CO 26 sts (112 + 8 + 28 = 146 sts)

Place a m and Work in round

Round21 : k all sts

Round22 : increase body + sleeves

k to m, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k to end of row (146 + 8 = 152 sts) **Round23 :** k all sts

Round 24 to 47 : repete last two rounds 12 times

You will have 152+96= 248 sts Front and back : 76 sts Sleeves : 48 sts

Separating body and sleeves :

Round48 : K to sm, remove m, k1, slip 48 sts on scrap yarn, remove m, CO 2 sts, pm, CO 2st, k1, remove m, k to m, remove m, k1, slip 48 sts on scrap yarn, remove m, CO 2sts, pm, CO 2sts, k1, remove m, k to m you placed in first 1st marker is the round marker now You will have 164 sts

Continue in stockinette sts and purl the st after each marker and start working stripes

Work stripes like this : Main Color : 8 rounds Contrast Color : 2 rounds

When you have finished 6th CC stripe work in main color to 35 cm (13.5 inch) or desired length from underarm

With 3 mm circular needles work in broken rib patt until 4 cm (1,5 inch), BO and cut yarn

3/4 Sleeves

With 3.5mm circular needles held 48 sleeves sts and pick up 4 sts underarm (pm in the midle) and join the round You will have 52 sts Work in stockinette sts in the round Knit 20 rounds Decrease round : K1, k2tog, k to the last 3 sts, ssk, k1 (2 sts dec) Repeat decrease round every 20th rounds 2 times more times You will have 46 sts Knit 2 rounds With 3 mm circular needles work 16 rounds of broken rib BO all sts

Abreviations :

k knit
p purl
m marker
sm slip marker
pm place marker
CO cast on
BO bind off
m1R make one increase right
m1L make one increase left
slp1 slip purlwise (with yarn in front)
k2tog Knit 2 together
ssk slip, slip knit
